- God's teaching is flawless and brings the soul to life.
- God's witness is true and gives us answers for our daily lives.
- God's principles or life maps are correct and lead us to joy.
- God's radiant directions give us understanding.
- God's revelation is pure and eternal and leads to awe-filled worship of God.
- God's decisions are true and absolutely right. They give us confidence to obey God.

David endorses God's Word as more valuable and desirable than anything else in the world.

David testifies that God's Word warns him of the danger of sin and directs him to treasure.

God's Word leads David to acknowledge and confess his sins and ask God to make him clean.

David closes his prayer song by worshipping God with his heartfelt words and thoughts.
