86:1-7

86:8-13

### A Servant's Petition

86:14-17

Ungodly men seek to take David's life, but David trusts God to deliver him.

David asks for God's strength to save him, instead of relying on his own.

David's victory is God's victory.

*\_\_\_\_\_ to those opposing you by appealing to your merciful God in difficult times.*

Name	Written in Scripture	Meaning	Used in Psalm 86
Yahweh	LORD	emphasizes His eternal presence and commitment to help His people	1, 6, 11, and 17
Elohim	God	emphasizes His power and sovereignty (i.e., Creator and Ruler)	2, 10, 12, and 14
Adoni	Lord	emphasizes His complete authority (i.e., Master)	3, 4, 5, 8, 9, 12, and 15
