


## the parable of the hidden treasure.

2. Read Matthew 13:44. Is there anything you wouldn't "sell," or sacrifice, for God's kingdom? Has God ever asked you to sacrifice something you didn't ever expect to?

- 3. Salvation itself is free, but what kinds of things would Jesus have us "sell off" as we bow the knee to Him? (One example would be *pride*.) What happens when we cling to our old ways and refuse to submit to His rule?
