JOHN 16:7-11

The Holy Spirit is the Third Person of the Trinity sent by God the Father and God the Son to equip and empower the believer for the work of the church and a witness to the world.

"Nevertheless, I tell you the truth: it is to your advantage that I go away, for if I do not go away, the Helper will not come to you. But if I go, I will send him to you. And when he comes, he will convict the world concerning sin and righteousness and judgment: concerning sin, because they do not believe in me; concerning righteousness, because I go to the Father, and you will see me no longer; concerning judgment, because the ruler of this world is judged." John 16:7-11

5. How has the Holy Spirit used you to bring glory to Jesus Christ? How would you like Him to use you in the future?

6. The Holy Spirit empowered the apostles to proclaim the gospel. How are you encouraged to seek the Holy Spirit in being equipped to tell others your faith story?

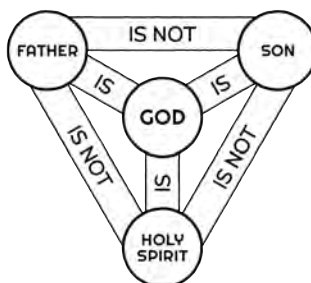
