
Where There's God's Will There's a Way

	But the high priest rose up, and all who were with him (that is, the party of the Sadducees), and filled with jealousy they arrested the apostles and put them in the public prison. And when they heard this, they entered the temple at daybreak and began to teach. vv. 17-21a

And when they had brought them, they set them before the council. And the high priest questioned them, saying, "We strictly charged you not to teach in this name, yet here you have filled Jerusalem with your teaching, and you intend to bring this man's blood upon us." But Peter and the apostles answered, "We must obey God rather than men." vv. 27-29

"So in the present case I tell you, keep away from these men and let them alone, for if this plan or this undertaking is of man, it will fail; but if it is of God, you will not be able to overthrow them. You might even be found opposing God!"

So they took his advice, and when they had called in the apostles, they beat them and charged them not to speak in the name of Jesus, and let them go. Then they left the presence of the council, rejoicing that they were counted worthy to suffer dishonor for the name. And every day, in the temple and from house to house, they did not cease teaching and preaching that the Christ is Jesus. vv. 38-42

POWER OF A CHANGED LIFE Home Group Discussion

Ask the Holy Spirit to reveal His truth and wisdom as you go through this lesson.

1. What circumstances at this point in your life are a "prison" for you?

'First, opposition may mean you're in the will of God, not out of it. Second, the will of God may set you against popular opinion, not with it. Difficult as it is to understand, Jesus never promised His followersthen or now-that living in a fallen world would be easy or bring popularity. Yet for some reason, we think that good fortune indicates God's pleasure or confirms that we are in His will. And we continue to suspect that painful circumstances indicate God's displeasure or that we have wandered outside His sovereign design. The fact is, God may will for His people to live as poor as dirt, to suffer rejection and sorrow, to endure outrageous injustice and then die painfully—just like His own Son and the apostles who followed Him." **CHARLES SWINDOLL**

- 2. Read Acts 5:17-42. How did the high priest and Sadducees respond to God's truth? Why?
- 3. Did putting the apostles in jail affect the truth of the gospel? Did it affect the will of God? Why or why not?
- 4. How did the sermon help you understand the will of God a bit better? Any thoughts that were new to you?
- 5. How does it encourage you to know more about God's purposes and desires in regard to His will? (See top section of sermon notes.)

6. Explain in your own words what Peter says about Jesus in verse 31. How is He your Prince and Savior? How can you represent Him as such even in your current circumstances?

- A WONDERFUL OFFER -

Being a Christian isn't based on membership in a local church or keeping a set of rules. It involves a personal relationship with Jesus Christ and an understanding of who He is and what He has done to provide man with a way to experience God's love for us. Here's how to know Jesus Christ as your personal Savior:

- 1. Realize that you are sinful and separated from God. (Romans 3:23; Isaiah 53:6)
- 2. Recognize that the penalty for your sin is death—eternal separation from God and all that is good. (Romans 6:23; Hebrews 9:27)
- 3. Understand that Jesus Christ took the penalty for your sin by dying in your place and that He rose again. (Romans 5:8; 2 Corinthians 5:21)
- 4. Receive the free gift of salvation by trusting in Christ alone as your Savior. (Romans 4:4-5; Ephesians 2:8-9) "For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish, but have eternal life." (John 3:16 NASB) You can use this prayer to express your decision to God: "Dear God, I know that I am a sinner. I believe that Jesus Christ died on the cross for me and rose from the dead. I trust in Him alone as the only way to get right with You. Thank You for the forgiveness of sins and the eternal life I now have. Amen.
