- 1. Start with God

 - o Abide in Him (John 15:5)
 - Pray = Ask for emotional intimacy
- 2. Then, humbly go to your spouse
 - o Be intentional (pursue, listen, love)
 - Show grace and humility (Colossians 3:12-15)
