What significant steps led to your decision to follow Christ? What needs, hurts or problems made you dissatisfied with the way you were living without God? How did God get your attention? What motivated you? What were you thinking? What were you feeling?

### 3. How I committed my life to Christ

How, specifically, did you place your faith and trust in Jesus Christ? Where did it happen? What did you say in your prayer? Be specific. Share the gospel (sin, substitutionary atonement, faith)!

### 4. The difference Christ has made in my life

How has your decision to trust Christ been fruitful or beneficial? What problems have been resolved? How has Jesus helped you change for the better? How has it helped your relationship? Give a current example.
